Summerschool Essence

The Interacting Summer School brings our philosophy of learning through games and theatre into practice. You will experience running your own theatre company for three weeks, facing the challenges of an opening night at the end of the course.

During the course the students will learn how to devise and perform a play of their own making. This process includes:

- Team work
- Decision making & Problem solving
- Self confidence
- Self awareness
- Improvisation
- Voice work
- Writing scripts
- Learning lines
- Staging
- Budgeting
- Dialogue

... and much more. **All in a safe and controlled environment.**

The course runs from **Monday to Friday** of each week. Each day is made up of three basic elements or interconnecting blocks:

The Living Language
